The Mayor and Council had a Regular Monthly Meeting on Monday, January 4, 2016 p.m. at City Hall, 4 Homer Street.

Minutes:

A motion was made by Councilmember Junior Hardy, seconded by Councilmember Charlie Howington to reappoint Judge Scott Tolbert as the Municipal Court Judge for the year of 2016. Motion carried.

There were two bids received for leak repairs at city hall. The lowest bid was Crawlspace.com LLC- \$6,700.00. Councilmember Kathy Bush asked if references had been checked on the company. Mayor Presley replied no, but we can table this until the references are checked out. A motion was made by Councilmember Charlie Howington, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper. Motion carried.
