A Memorandum of Agreement was approved for 0.04 acres of land between Stonepath Independent Church and the City of Maysville.

The property was donated to the city with understanding that they could access the road when needed. Motion was made by Councilmember Kathleen Bush, seconded by Richard Parr. Motion carried. Copy attached.
