

Regular Meeting

July 19, 2018

The Mayor and Council met on Thursday, July 19, 2018, 7:00 p.m. at 4 Homer Street for the Regular Monthly Meeting.

Present: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmember's Kathleen Bush, Richard Parr, Scott Harper and Junior Hardy, City Administrator/Clerk Barbara Thomas.

Mayor Presley opened up the meeting with the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

**MINUTES:**

The minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 14, 2018 and Called Meeting of June 26, 2018 was approved with one correction made to the last paragraph of the Regular Meeting of May 14, 2018. The park was changed to lake and March was changed to May 2019. Upon those corrections being made the motion to approve was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Kathleen Bush. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

The Banks County Mitigation Plan Update 2017-2022 was approved as read by a motion made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Kathleen Bush. Motion carried.

City Administrator/City Clerk stated that the 2019 Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) Program has been received and has to be turned in by January 2019. The council decided to table this until the next meeting to give time to ride the roads and see which roads might qualify under the program.

The inspection report from American Tank Company was not available in time for the meeting. This was tabled until the next meeting.

A discussion was held regarding holding a Community Christmas event in the park on December 8, 2018. This will be discussed at a later meeting.

Mayor Presley stated that the city is in need of another storage container. Discussion was held regarding a high cube container to store all the Christmas decorations. The council made a motion to approve \$3300.00 to purchase another container. Motion to approve was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper. Motion carried.
