The Mayor and Council met on Thursday, October 4, 2018, 7:40 a.m. at 4 Homer Street for a Special Called Meeting.

Present: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmember's Kathleen Bush, Richard Parr, Scott Harper and Junior Hardy, City Administrator/Clerk Barbara Thomas.

The second Public Hearing was held on Thursday, October 4, at 7:30 a.m. to amend the Soil, Erosion & Sedimentation and Pollution Control Ordinance. No one from the public was in attendance.

With no more discussion or questions on the amendment to the Ordinance, Mayor Presley asked that a motion be made to vote on the issue. A motion was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Kathleen Bush to accept the amendment to the Ordinance as discussed. Motion carried.

A discussion was held on the Water Tank Maintenance Agreement with American Tank Maintenance. Questions of concern was paying \$318,767 up front with no payments for 12 years. This would save the city approximately \$58,751 over 12 years. This was tabled to give more time to discuss this in details with City Attorney, Abbott Hayes.

Councilmember Scott Harper discussed the mixed use category on Sims Street. He was uncertain on the definition of mixed use and how it pertains to the Maysville Zoning Map. Caleb Davidson with Georgia Mountain Regional Commission will be notified to clear up all the questions. The Resolution will be voted on in the next upcoming meeting.

A motion was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper to adjourn the meeting.
