The Mayor and Council for the City of Maysville met on Monday, March 18, 2019, 6:00 p.m...

PRESENT: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmembers Kathleen Bush, Junior Hardy, Richard Parr and Scott Harper, City Administrator/City Clerk Barbara Thomas.

Mayor Presley opened the meeting with introduction of Chip McGaughey and Fletcher Holiday of EMI.

Fletcher Holiday and Chip McGaughey commented on the violation that was received from Georgia Department of Natural Resources Environmental Protection Division during the third and fourth quarter of 2018. During a review of sample analysis results, the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) determined that the City's Water System exceeded the maximum contaminant level (MCL) for total Haloacetics Acids (HAA5) at sampling point 501.

A letter and report was sent to EPD which referenced the Corrective Plan (CPA) that the city will take to correct the problem. The letter stated that the City will implement a seasonal system wide unidirectional flushing program and will consider installation of automatic flush valves at key locations.

Discussion was held regarding what can be done about the violations that the city is receiving. Fletcher Holiday and Chip McGaughey of EMI highly recommended looking into drilling more wells for the town to be more self-sufficient.

The city will have a Hydrologists check for water at several locations in the city. The well on 82 Spur that belongs to Ricky Veal and James Shorts will be tested to see if they are useable.
