

The Mayor and Council for the City of Maysville met on Thursday, March 14, 2019, 7:45 a.m. at 4 Homer Street.

PRESENT: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmembers Kathleen Bush, Junior Hardy, Scott Harper, Richard Parr, Attorney Abbott Hayes, City Administrator Barbara Thomas was not present.

Mayor Presley opened the meeting with the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The minutes of January 6, 2020 was approved as read. Motion to approve was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Discussion was held in a previous Public Hearing on Article 16, Section 1. Nuisances Ordinance as presented by the Planning and Zoning Board. Mayor Presley asked for a motion to vote on the Ordinance. The motion was made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Kathleen Bush to deny Article 16, Section 1. Nuisances Ordinances. Motion carried.

New Business:

A bid of \$2,403.00 was approved from James Matt Ousts to tint the windows in city hall. The motion to approve the bid was made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Kathleen Bush. Motion carried.

Jackson County jail charges would be increasing from \$35.00 to \$40.00 per month. The rate increase was approved upon a motion made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Junior Hardy. Motion carried.

Laura White gave a presentation on a program that helps cities revitalize their downtown areas. This program is available to small town communities. Ms. White is assisting the city by applying for this assistance.

Public Comment:

Wayne Parr spoke on the two story storage shed that Laura White has built behind her resident at 16 Homer Street.

Harold Kilgore spoke on the dilapidated buildings in the downtown area. Stated that the state has building codes that will take place if the city does not enforce citizens to clean up the dilapidated buildings.
