

Special Called Meeting

July 27, 2020

The Mayor and Council for the City of Maysville met at 4 Homer Street on Monday, July 27, 2020, 6:00 p.m. in the Conference Room.

Present: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmembers Kathleen Bush, Junior Hardy, Richard Parr and Scott Harper, City Administrator/City Clerk Barbara Thomas.

Mayor Presley opened up the Special Called Meeting with the motion made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper. Motion carried.

Joey Anderson, President of ACNS Computer and Networking talked to the Council about IT work that is needed by the city. Mr. Anderson said the city needs Firewall protection, iCloud backup at night and ransomware protection. His proposal was a flat fee of \$1200 to \$1500 up front and a monthly fee of \$50.00 per computer. If he needs to come on site it would be an additional fee of \$110.00 per hour. If they dial in remotely to fix an issue there would be no additional fee charged.

A motion was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper to accept the above proposal from ACNS Computer and Networking based on the City Attorney approving the contract.

Mr. Anderson will forward a contract over to City Administrator/City Clerk Barbara Thomas. Once that is received it will be forwarded over to City Attorney Abbott Hayes for his approval.

Mayor Presley asked each Councilmember to review the following 5 applicants for the Police Chief position.

The Council discussed hiring a part time person (10) hours a week to work in the Maysville Library. Jordan Wilmoth will be leaving to go back to school August 14th and will only be able to work on Friday's. A motion was made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Kathleen Bush to hire a person 10 hours a week. Motion carried.
