

The Mayor and Council for the City of Maysville met on Monday, May 2, 2022, at 4 Homer Street, 7:00 p.m...

Present: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmembers, Junior Hardy, Richard Parr, Scott Harper, City Administrator/City Clerk Barbara Thomas.

Mayor Presley opened the meeting with the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. The invocation was given by Councilmember Junior Hardy.

The minutes of Regular Meeting, April 11, 2022, was approved as read by a motion made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Richard Parr. Motion carried.

Bids for Pest Control:

Ten bids were taken for the annual pest control. Bids were reviewed and tabled to give more time to review each bid more closely.

Laura White of the Maysville DDA was present to report on the upcoming plans for the Memorial Day Event on May 28, 2022. There will be music, and cornhole games. Food will be available by local vendors.

The final reading was held on the Ordinance to reapportion the election districts due to the recent census increases. The map will be sent over to Georgia Mountain Regional Commission for updates on each ward.

The Council approved a warehouse at 170 College Avenue. This will be divided up into several business offices and rented out.

Pritchett Road was tabled due to Mayor Presley talking with County Manager Kevin Poe. A report will be given at next month's meeting.

The purchase of a bush hog was approved from James Short Tractors and Equipment of Alto, Inc., \$2,295.00.

Approval was given by Council to give 244 Jade Way a credit of \$635.00 on their water bill due to a mechanical default in their meter. Motion to approve was made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Richard Parr. Motion carried.

Approval was given to purchase a 48" Brush Cutter with a 6" cutting capacity from James Short Tractors and Equipment, Inc., 8,385.00. The motion to approve the purchase was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Scott Harper. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned a 7:45 p.m. by a motion made by Councilmember Scott Harper, seconded by Councilmember Junior Hardy. Motion carried.
