The Mayor and Council held a drop in Advisory Meeting on Thursday, March 1, 2018, 6:00 p.m. at 4 Homer Street.

Present were: Mayor Richard Presley, Councilmembers Kathleen Bush, Junior Hardy, Richard Parr and Scott Harper were not present, City Administrator/City Clerk Barbara Thomas, Caleb Davidson.

Mayor Presley opened up the meeting with introduction of Caleb Davidson, With Georgia Mountain Regional Commission. Mr. Davidson is assisting the city with updating the State required Comprehensive Plan.

The plan is a vision on what the citizens would like to see happen in the next five years. There will be several meeting over the next couple of months to make sure the process is complete and ready to send to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs. This process has to be completed in order to get state and federal grant funds.

Mr. Davidson stated that this document will help guide future policies and actions in accordance with a loyalty-derived vision for the community, and will ensure that Maysville will have full access to all forms of State assistance and resources.
