

The Mayor and Council for the City of Maysville met on Monday, March 4, 2024, at Homer Street.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE

The Minutes of Regular Meeting February 4, 2024, was approved as read. The motion to approve was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Amanda Farley. Motion carried.

The Minutes of Special Called Meeting February 8, 2024, was approved as read. The motion to approve was made by Councilmember Richard Parr, seconded by Councilmember Amanda Farley. Motion carried.

New Business:

Council member Amanda Farley made a motion to change the council meeting start time to 6:00pm. Councilmember Brodriche Jackson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kimberly Wilmoth made a motion to increase the clerk/administrator salary to \$30 per hour and the water utility clerk to \$20 per hour. Richard Parr seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Richard Parr made a motion for Scott Harper to handle cemetery requests/needs as they arrive and to compensate him \$50.00 each time, he is required to go to the City's cemetery to meet with those interested in purchasing a cemetery plot. Councilmember Amanda Farley seconded the motion. Motion carried.

City Attorney, Doug Kidd addressed the City Council and Citizens regarding recent requests to allow alcohol sales in the city limits of Maysville. He explained if the City Council did vote to allow, it would be a 60-90-day process involving several work sessions/meetings, town hall meetings, and an ordinance re-write with two readings. The Mayor and Council agreed to hold a town hall meeting on March 21, 2024 at 6:00 pm in the Maysville Fire Station to allow for adequate space.

Councilmember Richard Parr made a motion to allow Blackstone Contracting to move forward with the repair and rebuild of the Wall @ Comer Street in the amount of \$28,000.00 as well as repairing the curb inlet on Industrial Drive in the amount of \$3750.00. Councilmember Kimberly Wilmoth seconded the motion. Motion carried.
