PURSUANT TO: SECTION 40-06-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated concerning alteration of speed limits by local authorities, the following ordinance regulating speed limits within Maysville, Georgia is adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED: BY the City Council and the Mayor of Maysville, Georgia that the following speed zones are established based on a Traffic Engineering Investigation as REQUIRED by Georgia Law.

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT this is a legal & binding document and ANY unauthorized changes will cause it to be VOID in it's entirety. This includes the removal, installation and/or relocation of signs erected on State Right-of-Way of ANY written changes made to this Speed Zone Ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT it is unlawful to use radar detection devices on ANY state route, county road or city street NOT listed on this ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT this is a legal & binding document and ANY unauthorized changes will cause it to be VOID in it's entirety.

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished as provided by Georgia Law.

BE IT RESOLVED: THAT the City of Maysville agrees to allow the Jackson/Banks County Sheriff's Offices to enforce the zones established in this ordinance.

Subject: Speed Zone Ordinance/Radar Permit Upgrade for Maysville, Ga.

Dear Mayor Jarrett:

The Office of Traffic Operations has recently completed a Speed Study for Maysville, Ga. and a new Speed Zone Ordinance has been compiled. We are enclosing three copies of this ordinance for your convenience, in establishing what we feel to be fair and enforceable speed limits. After approval, please return two signed/notarized copies to this office so that Maysville's Speed Zone Ordinance can be amended to reflect this newer case study.

We have found that a number of Mayors are under the impression that the County Sheriff's Office has the authority to enforce speed zones in their cities. This could not be further from the truth. In order for another agency to enforce your speed zones, your city MUST agree to this in writing and a copy of your speed ordinance must be attached to theirs and sent through the proper channels to The Dept. of Public Safety. Then and ONLY then are they authorized to enforce your Speed Zones. If a city does not have a governing body, that is another story but if a city has a mayor/city council, permission MUST be granted.

We are requesting that you return two signed/notarized copies, of the first page, of your speed zone ordinance. Please, read this page carefully and answer the section that requires your permission for Jackson County to enforce your speed zones. If you agree, indicate with a YES in the "DOES" space and if you disagree, indicate with a NO in the "DOES NOT" space. PLEASE, TYPE PRINT YOUR PREFERENCE. This doesn't make it any more legal but it does make it harder to choose the wrong selection caused by someone quickly penning a choice.

The Dept. of Transportation Personnel will erect any necessary signs, on the State Route System.
