CITY ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

(A) DEFINITIONS. THE FOLLOWING WORDS, TERMS AND PHRASES, WHEN USED IN THIS SECTION, SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS ASCRIBED TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION, EXCEPT WHEN THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES A DIFFERENT MEANING.

FIREARMS INCLUDES PISTOLS, RIFLES AND SHOTGUNS, OPERATED BY THE DISCHARGE OF AN EXPLOSIVE POWDER.


(B) ACT PROHIBITED. NO PERSON SHALL DISCHARGE ANY FIREARM WITHIN THE CITY EXCEPT:


(1) LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE CITY, COUNTY, STATE OR FEDERAL AGENCIES WHO ARE ENGAGED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

(2) COMPETITORS IN ORGANIZED SHOOTING EVENTS HELD AT RANGES WHICH HAVE BEEN REGISTERED AND APPROVED BY THE CITY PURSUANT TO RULES PROMULGATED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.


(C) PENALTY. ANY PERSON FOUND GUILTY OF VIOLATING THIS ORDINANCE MAY, UPON CONVICTION BE SUBJECT TO PENALTIES NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.
