

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Maysville, Georgia that an Ordinance hereafter known as the Disorderly Conduct Ordinance be adopted by the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Maysville at the meeting of October 20, 1997 to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person in the city to engage in any violent, tumultuous, obstreperous, or similar disorderly conduct tending to infringe on the peace and repose of the citizens of the city. Fighting between two or more persons in which physical contact is made, except that which occurs at boxing or wrestling exhibitions duly authorized by the city, shall be deemed to be disorderly conduct within the meaning of this section. Persons found in violation of this section shall be fined one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
