

**RESOLUTION TO APPOINT THE CHIEF JUDGE OF MUNICIPAL COURT
UNDER SECTION 4.11 OF THE MAYSVILLE CITY CHARTER**

WHEREAS, the City of Maysville is a municipality duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and the City Council is charged with appointing certain positions under the City's Charter, including Chief Judge of the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter gives the City Council the responsibility to appoint the Chief Judge under Section 4.11(b), in that "all judges shall be appointed by the city council and shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified."

WHEREAS, City Council desires to appoint a Chief Judge of the Municipal Court;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Maysville finds that the foregoing appointment is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the efficient operation of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the City of Maysville as follows:


APPOINTMENT – The City Council hereby appoints Christopher Dyal as the Chief Judge of the Maysville Municipal Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Mayor of Maysville.

PASSED AND RESOLVED this 7 day of April, 2025, nunc pro tunc to May 6, 2024.


