AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX PROPERTY LYING ADJACENT TO, BUT NOT NOW WITHIN CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE, GEORGIA



conditions at intersection of May 98 & May 52. Letter read to Council by Mayor asking for Ordinance to correct this problem. Andrew motions, Otis seconds, Council adopts ordinance proposed by DOT.
