

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF
MAYSVILLE, GEORGIA, TO UPDATE THE PENALTY FOR THE OFFENSE OF
ANIMAL CONTROL VIOLATION AND FINE AMOUNT THERETO; REPEAL
CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the City of Maysville, Georgia is a municipality duly constituted and existing pursuant to Georgia law; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update the set fee schedule for the criminal offenses of “Animal Control Violation – First Offense” and “Animal Control Violation – Second Offense” under City Code Section 98.2, Sec. 1-2 and added to the City’s “Schedule of Fine”; and

WHEREAS, the efficiency of the Municipal Court of Maysville, Georgia will be positively affected by the adoption of this Ordinance; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Maysville, by the lawful authority vested in them, that the City’s “Schedule of Fines” is hereby amended as adding the following:

- I. **Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of \$209.00 for the first offense. A second offense shall be punished by a fine of \$275.00. Any subsequent offense may be punished by the maximum amount allowed for the violation of city ordinances by state law. Applicable court costs shall be levied in addition to any fine imposed.**
- II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.
- III. Should any provision of this ordinance be rendered invalid by a court of law, the remaining provisions shall continue in force and effect until amended or repealed by action of the City Council.
- IV. This Ordinance shall take effect December 1, 2025.






