II. Approval of Minutes

- a. Approval of Minutes December 1, 2025 Regular Called Minutes

Councilmember Farley made a motion to approve the minutes from December 1, 2025 as printed, Councilmember Parr seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

a. EMI Update

Chip McGahee from EMI gave an update, the smoke testing report should be ready next month. The tanks and pump plans will be submitted to the EPD hopefully next month. Chip presented a quote from Processworx for the installation of the new flow meter for \$5,900.00. This will be paid for out of Water repair. This is for the flow meter leaving the wastewater pond.

Councilmember Parr made a motion to approve the \$5,900 to fix the situation before we get fined, Councilmember Boswell seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

b. Old Voting Precinct Building Update

Attorney Kid contacted the Presbyterian Church office about the building. The city clerk the get pictures of the building to the attorney to send to them to let them know the condition of property.

a. New Business -Charles McLellon Boiled Peanut at 76 Station

c. Waste Pro

Waste Pro will be increasing their rates; 1 can \$17.55, 2 cans \$32.45, 3 cans \$47.40 and 4 cans \$62.35.

Councilmember Farley made the motion to approve the increase for Waste pro. Councilmember Parr seconded the motion. Farley, Parr, Bowell voted in favor. Jackson voted against. Motion carried.

Councilmember Farley wanted to inquire if the courts needed to look into adding more dates and times for courts. It was determined that a new way of court may have solved the issues they were having and they would try this way a few more courts and re visit if there were any more issues.

e. Fire Jeep Purchase

Councilmember Parr would like to purchase a 1967 Jeep Brush truck with a tank and pump on the back. This could be used to clean out ditches and sewer. The Maysville fire department would sell this for \$875.00. This will come out of Grounds and Roads budget.

Councilmember Parr made the motion to approve the Purchase of the fire truck for \$875.00. Councilmember Boswell seconded the motion. Parr, Bowell and Presley voted in favor. Jackson and Farley voted against. Motion carried.
