##### **a. EMI Update**

##### **a. DDA End of Year, Proposed Calendar, and Budget**

The DDA gave an update on their 2025 event and budget. They also presented a proposal to increase their budget to \$100,000, this would include hiring a Main Street Program Coordinator and their salary. This is used for economic revitalization, marketing and outreach, finding grant and funding opportunities and writing those grants. Steve Boswell has volunteered to be the Councilmember representative for DDA.

**b. Jackson County Inmate Housing Contract**

Jackson County as increase the cost of inmate housing from \$40.00 to \$60.00, this contract will need to be approved at the next meeting.

**a. Sears Drive Fence Exception**

Ken Cannon Who lives on Sears Drive would like to put a 53" 3 rail wood black fence in his yard. The regulation calls for 48", he would like to match his neighbors on the road. The ROW is 31 feet from the center of the road.

**c. Library Trustee**

Susan McLeigh has had to resign from her position as a library trustee for personal reasons. Julie Duncan would like to recommend Pamela Luiz to take her place.

**b. Department Head Update**

The library lost gutters in the ice storm that froze and fell off. The construction project will go out to bid soon for the library.

Chief looked into tasers and for 6 tasers the cost is \$45,998. There is financing available. Also, the Jack brake signs GDOT will need us to buy, for 4 signs the cost will be \$1,108.28.


