Councilmember Jackson made a motion to adjourn into executive session at 6:22, Councilmember Parr seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.


Councilmember Parr made a motion to adjourn out of executive session at 6:45, Councilmember Farley seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
