

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE, GEORGIA,
TO CREATE A DATA CENTER COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City of Maysville ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is desirable to create a committee to review and recommend positions the City can take in negotiating with any current or future data center project, and wishes to establish a method of appointment and composition of a Data Center Committee, as well as establish the duties and scope of the committee;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maysville that the Data Center Committee is hereby created.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following shall apply to the Data Center Committee for the City of Maysville.

1. The Data Center Committee shall consist of nine (9) members. Each member shall serve in such capacity for the duration of this specific review. Members shall either be a resident of the City of Maysville or own a business in the city limits of Maysville.

Two (2) members of the committee shall be City Council members, one (1) member shall be a member of the Downtown Development Authority, one (1) member shall be a member of the Planning and Zoning committee, and five (5) members shall be residents of Maysville or business owners in Maysville.

2. The appointed Data Center Committee shall vote to designate the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Secretary of the Committee at its initial meeting.

3. The Chairperson shall preside over all meetings. In the absence of the Chairperson, the Vice Chairperson shall preside.

4. A quorum of the Data Center Committee shall consist of five (5) members.

5. Upon appointment of members to the Data Center Committee, an initial meeting date and time shall be set. At its first meeting, the Data Center Committee shall set a meeting schedule of periodic meeting dates and times.

6. Members of the Data Center Committee shall serve without compensation.

7. Any member of the Data Center Committee may be removed by the City Council for malfeasance, failure to attend three or more consecutive meetings (except for absences due to illness of the Committee member or an immediate family member), or willful neglect of duty. The City Council shall fill the vacancy in the same manner as the original appointment.

8. The Data Center Committee shall convene beginning August 25, 2026, 2026 for a term not to exceed 60 days, unless such term is extended by the Maysville City Council.

9. The Maysville City Clerk shall be responsible for administrative support to the Data Center Committee.

10. All meetings of the Data Center Committee shall be open to the public and meetings and notices shall conform to the Open Meetings Act (O.C.G.A. §50-14-1, et seq.)

11. The Data Center Committee shall submit its final written recommendation(s) of any suggested ideas or negotiation strategies to the Mayor and Council upon completion, but no later than October 25, 2026 unless the deadline for such submittal is extended by the Maysville City Council.
